

RAGSDALE HIGH SCHOOL PTSA GENERAL MEETING
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2012

- I. The third General Meeting of the Ragsdale PTSA was called to order in the Ragsdale Auditorium on Monday, February 27th by President Rebecca Scheffer. The evening had been opened by Student Body President Sandra Hoyt with the presentation of the colors by the Ragsdale Air Force Junior ROTC and the Pledge of Allegiance.
- II. Discussed Senior Extravaganza which is a drug and alcohol free all-night party for Ragsdale seniors. The Extravaganza committee is having several fundraising events to raise funds for the event. Saturday, March 3rd – Applebee’s Flapjack Breakfast for \$7.00 and Tuesday, April 3rd – Outback Dinner for \$15.00, 4 for \$50.00. Dinner is picked up at school.
- III. President Scheffer introduced Karen Kantziper who gave a slide presentation on the We R Ragsdale campaign. Karen explained the purpose of the campaign and the benefits that will be gained from the campaign. She discussed the fundraising aspect and that the committee is trying to raise \$52,000 for items that are not included in the current construction but will add value to the campus and the students. Items discussed were picnic tables and benches for the outdoor patio, trash receptacles, directional signage and an LED sign.
- IV. President Scheffer introduced PTSA Treasurer Sara Lempp who presented PTSA Board recommendations for amendments to the 2011 – 2012 Budget. These amendment recommendations had been adopted by the PTSA Board at the February 6, 2012 meeting.
 - a. Adjust Income by \$4,000 as a carryover from the previous year’s funds (\$3,000 to be used for We R Ragsdale and \$1,000 for Enrichment Grants.
 - b. Create an Income Line Item for We R Ragsdale Fundraising in the amount of \$49,000.
 - c. Increase the budgeted amount for Enrichment Grants by \$1,000 to accommodate additional needs. (Note: budgeted amount changes from \$3,000 to \$4,000)
 - d. Create an Expense Line Item for We R Ragsdale proposed expenses in the amount of \$52,000.

After opening the floor to discussion and questions, Sara called the Budget Amendment to a vote and it was approved unanimously by the General Membership.

- V. President Scheffer closed the meeting at 6:25 PM.
